04. INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The IQAC has contributed significantly for the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) to take into account the processes of teaching-learning in all disciplines and to institutionalize the quality in all academic and administrative matters of the College. Some of the measures taken in this regard are:

Devising strategies to improve the teaching-learning process through increased use of ICT, expanding the scope of the library, transforming it into a multivalent knowledge portal and signing MoUs with research institute to re-define the boundaries of meaningful and holistic education.

The implementation of academic calendar, focus on the syllabus to be taught, distribution of time- table, curriculum delivery, compliance as per the schedule, assigning of academic responsibilities and internal committees' formulation for various

department activities. All the achievements and activities are compiled in the form of departmental profiles.

The documents of internal assessment, policy for moderation of marks and analysis of the results of semester examinations are carefully examined as per audit process protocol.

A platform for engaging with students and addressing their concerns, regularly takes place via carefully designed teacher- student mentoring programs.

IQAC has implemented the feedbacks system from students based on institutional parameters such as infrastructure and facilities, curriculum delivery and pedagogy, discipline and environment, staff and support etc.

05. COURSES OFFERED

Believing that each student is special and has the potential to excel in many different ways, the college imparts instruction in different streams: Humanities (the students are offered a choice of 20 subjects in general and 10 subjects in Honours course), Science, Commerce, Bio-Technology, Business Administration, Computer Applications and Physical Education where B.P.Ed. is a 4-year course. The college has Post-Graduate courses in Chemistry, Commerce, English, Punjabi, Physical Education, History and Information Technology. There is research centre in Physical Education leading to Ph.D degree. Other departments like English, Sociology, Economics and Psychology too offer Ph.D. supervision.

06. INFRASTRUCTURE

The institution has 60 classrooms. Twenty seven class rooms are equipped with ICT facilities. The campus is fully Wi-Fi enabled for uninterrupted use of internet facilities for all. The college has 352computers, projectors and printers/scanners in various labs and departments. The college library is fully automated with LIBSYS software and has access to INFLIBNET N-LIST, and Web-OPAC. Photocopy facility is also available inside the library. There are 32 laboratories in the college including those for computers, RTV studio, science labs, and language workstation. The infrastructure provides easy access to differently able students in terms of ramps, wheelchair, software in the library and adequate washrooms.

The campus is equipped with adequate seminar and conference halls, auditorium, hostels, playgrounds, a health centre and Open Air Theater for extension activities. The campus is equipped with CCTV cameras, electronic display boards, automatic electronic bells and biometric face reading machines.

PGGC Chandigarh provides adequate facilities for cultural activities and sports for allinclusive development of the students. Sports inculcate a sense of discipline, cooperation, social harmony, integrity, healthy competition, teamwork and fitness among the students.

Facilities for cultural activities

The College has one open stage for practice and performance. The campus has auditorium to facilitate cultural activities with a seating capacity of 400. Auditorium is a central space for all types of formal assemblies. The Conference Room and Seminar Room are also available for organizing the extracurricular activities. The Cultural Committee prepares the students for various competitive events of the youth festival. Giddha, Bhangra, Fine Arts and Dramatics, Heritage items are all presented at these competitions. College Annual Day and department wise activities are also conducted in the college to promote cultural activities.

Facilities for Sports

The campus has a sports pavilion with a seating capacity of 400 students. Our college is the only college in Tricity which has a cinder track of 400 meters. A flash back well fenced swimming pool is another attraction for students. This pool has its own filtration plant and separate changing room for boys and girls. The multipurpose gymnasium hall has huge space which is used for indoor activities like badminton, wrestling, Judo and yoga. There are two grounds one for cricket and another for football. College infrastructure includes volleyball courts, basketball courts, one each for hockey, khokho and handball.

- Recently two synthetic tennis courts have been constructed
- Caging of Handball Court, Basketball Court and Volleyball Court was recently completed.
- His Excellency Banwarilal Purohit ji, Hon'ble Governor Punjab, and Administrator, UT, Chandigarh laid the foundation stone of the Advanced Academic and Research Centre. This research center set up at 9.93 crores with 2930 sqm of covered area, aims to foster Critical thinking, innovation, and problem-solving among the academic community as research contributes to the development of knowledge, new technologies, and solutions that can address societal challenges and drive economic growth.

07. LIBRARY

The Library is the teaching-learning hub for the faculty and students. College library is well-equipped with the latest infrastructure, stocked with a good collection of books and periodicals. It is fully computerized, centrally air-conditioned, equipped with sixteen CCTV cameras and INFLIBNET database. It is very spacious with seating capacity of 220 students at a time. Library automation is extremely important in this age of technology. Due to immense growth in the different fields of knowledge, there is a need for access to the desired literature. The college library is fully automated with LIBSYS software (Web Centric LSEase on cloud) along with Web OPAC and 18 desktop systems. Libsys is integrated library system software designed and developed to manage small and large library operations. Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) accessible with LAN, is installed in the library to ensure easy access to books. The

Library also provides access to about 6000 plus e-journals and 1,99,500+ ebooks under N-List and 6,00,000+ e-books through NDL.

The Library has the subscription for online resources such as e-Journals, e- books, databases, etc. in addition to regular books, journals, magazines, newspapers etc. News clippings are being sent to the faculty by Email. Library maintains an online database of old question papers of graduate and post- graduate level through the college website to benefit its 192 affiliated colleges of Panjab University, Chandigarh. Separate almirah is there for rare books in the library. It has a diverse collection of 1,10,124 books, 473 CDs of various disciplines, and 22 print journals. The library subscribes to 16 newspapers and 58 magazines and has a rich collection of reference texts such as encyclopaedia, dictionaries, atlas, and yearbooks. All the books in the library are bar-coded and are arranged according to DDC (Dewey decimal classification scheme). There is a Braille section for visually challenged students in the library with text to speech software. The main library is divided into different sections i.e Circulation Section, Textbook Section, Digital Corner Reference Section, Periodical Section with a spacious reading Room. Library has a Heritage furniture gallery of the Le-Corbusier Era. There is a book bank corner consisting of (approx. 6000 books) all donated /free books.

08. IT INFRASTRUCTURE

The PGGC ensures an extensive use of ICT facilities by providing adequate access to computers and internet to its students and faculty. There are eight computer laboratories equipped with desktops having the latest configuration systems. Over 350 computers were deployed across the Campus to giving computing facility to the students and faculty for hands on practical sessions. The college has 300 computers of which 176 are in different labs for students. The college has 60 classrooms of which 27 are IT enabled smart classrooms and the campus is fully Wi-Fi. The internet is managed with SOPHOS internet firewall. The College has two dedicated (1:1) internet leased line connections (150 Mbps and 50 Mbps) which are catering the internet needs. To make the learning process more productive various innovative methods such as group assignments and PowerPoint presentations are used by Faculty. The college library is fully automated. The college library has JAWS software for visually impaired students. The library is equipped with 01 server and 17 desktops. Wide range of e-books and e-journals are available through INFLIBNET. Public address conference system is installed

in the conference room and seminar room. There is a digital display board outside the auditorium to display the latest news of the college. The college website is maintained and upgraded regularly. It has different portals with latest updates.

09. COLLEGE HOSTELS

The college provides three hostels for its students coming from length and breadth of the country and across seven seas. For boys, there are two hostels viz., the Main Hostel that is within the college campus and the General Hostel in Sector 15B. For girl students, there is one hostel within the campus. 194 boys and 146 girls are residing in the above mentioned three hostels. Moreover, 61 girls are being accommodated in various other hostels in the vicinity in Chandigarh. All the hostels are spacious, green and offer a home away from home to its students.

Every year, the Hostel committee of both boys and girls celebrate various festivals like Deepawali, Holi, Gurpurab, Eid, Christmas etc. In addition to these events, Fresher's party and awareness seminars for girls and boys are regularly conducted.

Facilities Provided:

- 1. In all the three hostels the students are offered residential accommodation in the best possible living environment
- 2. Spacious rooms allotted on twin sharing basis furnished with Two beds, Study table, Two chairs and Wardrobes
- TV/Music Room There is a cozy TV/Music room in the hostel to unwind after a hectic day in the college including Indoor games
- 4. Common Room / Study Room / Library The hostels have a huge multi-purpose common room which is used for interactive session. This hall/room doubles up as the study room where students study together in large group. There is a library corner in this room which is very useful for the students
- 5. Visitor's Room where the students meet their visitors
- 6. A huge courtyard & central lawn provide place for the students to relax
- 7. In girls hostel there is an in-house nurse to take care of the girls

10. ACTIVITIES UNDER RUSA

- RUSA is a centrally sponsored, overarching holistic and comprehensive umbrella scheme for norm-based funding for the State Universities and Colleges to achieve the goals of expansion, equity and excellence with the aim of imparting relevant and value-based education for improving employability.
- RUSA grant greatly enables the growth of the infrastructure of our institution. This institution was mainly built to cater 700 students but now it is hosting more than 5000 students.
- RUSA grant has helped us improve the facilities for the increasing student numbers to achieve academic excellence. This was mainly done by acquiring new instruments, equipment, girls common room and college renovations.
- Total Sanction grant for RUSA 2.0 Crore out of which 1.5 Crore was received and utilized. 90 Lakh was spent on new equipment and 60 lakh was spent on renovation/upgradation.
- Renovation of washrooms in IT and Defence Studies Departments.
- 45 laptops were purchased for Faculty.
- Renovation of Staff Room for Faculty and Girls Common Room.
- Lab equipment was purchased for all Science Departments.
- Open Gym in Girls Hostel and in playground etc.

There is a full-fledged SBI branch in the college campus. An ATM has been installed by the bank in the college premises for facilitating transactions both for the faculty as well as the students. - Steam Inhalation and Nebulisation for patients suffering from cold and cough.
- Hand sanitizers are made available in the places having more footfalls.
