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ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Post Graduate Government College, Sector-11, Chandigarh; right from its inception in 1953 has been a premier institute in the region with a vision of academic excellence, creativity and multifaceted development of its students. The College building which was originally designed by E. Maxwell Fry to accommodate 700 students now has more than 5300 students. Spread over 43.8 acres the campus has excellent infrastructure and facilities. It is a matter of pride that the College has been granted 'A' grade in NAAC accreditation in 2017. College is running bachelor courses in Arts, Science, Commerce and Computer Science like B.A., B.Sc., BCA, B.Com, B.B.A. and Post Graduation in Chemistry, Information Technology, History, English and Punjabi, Commerce. Department of Physical Education- Teaching Education Learning & Research is running B.P.Ed, M.P.Ed, M.Phil and Ph.D programme. With proud legacy of 65 years, many college students have registered their presence in the merit list of Panjab University. The hard work and guidance of the highly dedicated and qualified faculty helped the students to carve a niche in competitive examinations in various fields at national and international levels. Co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are organized to facilitate the process of creative and critical thinking. More than 150 students every year are participating in Panjab University Zonal and Inter-zonal

The College proudly claims to have three wings of NCC since the inception of College. The Army, Navy and Air force enrolls cadets in the first year to prepare cadets for B & C certificates for Direct entry to three wings of the Armed Forces. The NCC Air Wing is open to students of both the gender. The College has a proud legacy of more than 500 serving and retired personnel as officers. Every year, the cadets participate in the prestigious Republic Day Parade at New Delhi and International Youth Exchange Programmes. 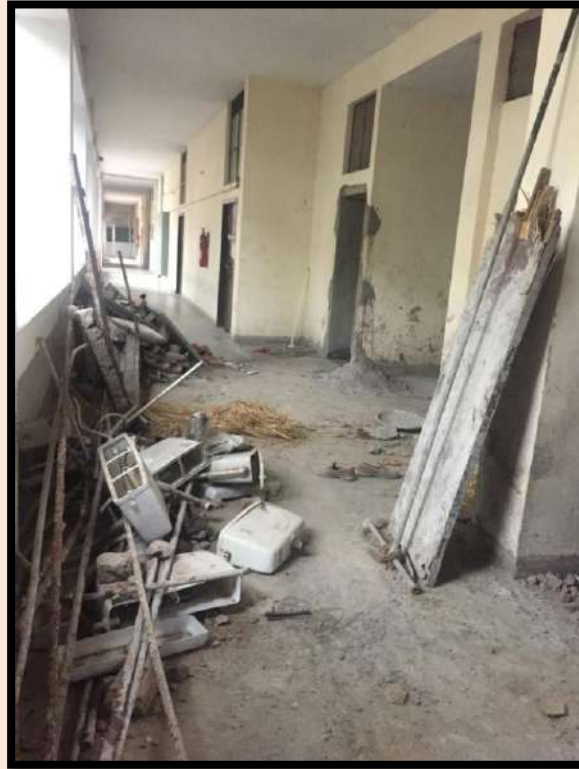

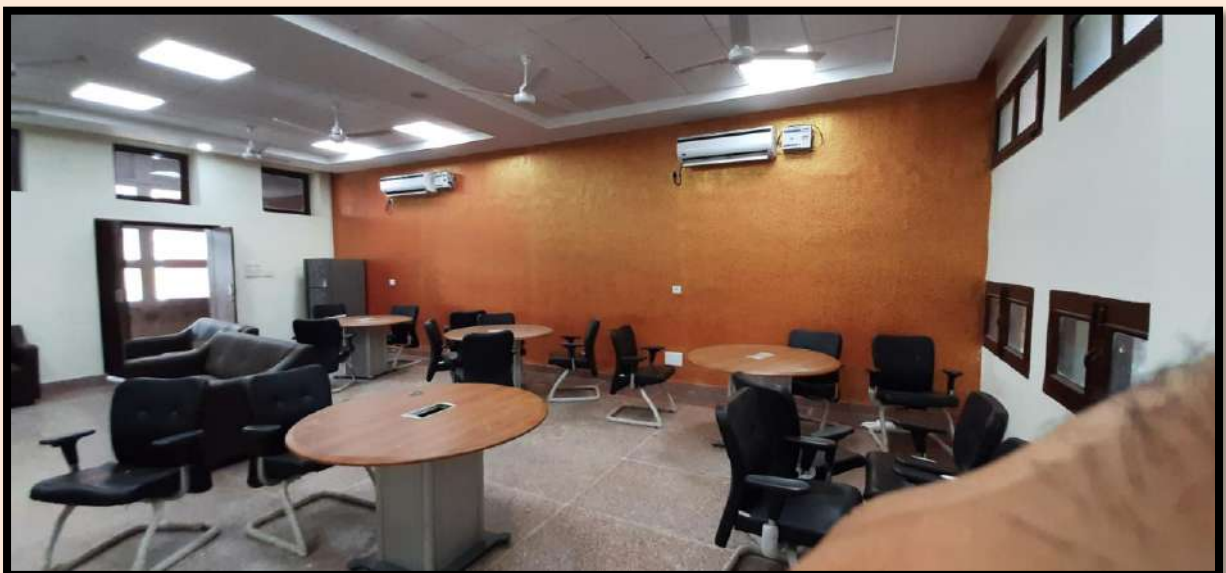

The RUSA Infrastructure Grant has been utilized for the renovation of Faculty Staff Room, Girls Common Room and Washrooms.

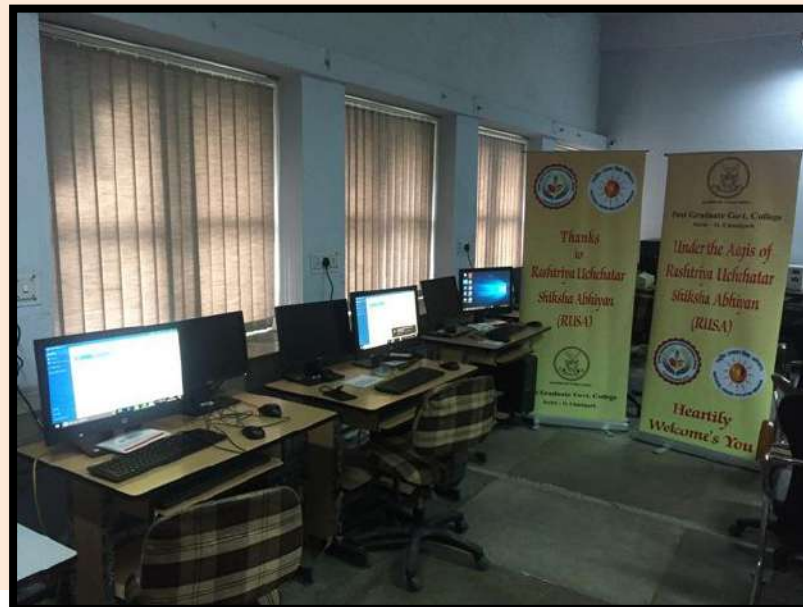
